Denteler is committed to protecting your privacy.

Website Privacy

We will not collect any information about individuals, except where it is specifically and knowingly provided by them.

When you visit our website, our web server collects some basic information such as your internet service provider's domain name, which pages you accessed on our site, and when.

We use this information only to analyse the use of our website to help guide improvements. We do not collect any personally identifiable information.

Cookies

When you visit our website, we use cookies, which are small pieces of information that allow us to maintain your connection to our website. These cookies do not collect or store any personally identifiable information. You can refuse the use of cookies.

Do Not Track

Denteler adhere to the standards set out in this Privacy Notice and does not monitor or respond to Do Not Track browser requests.

Individual users can enable their browsers to send DNT requests in addition to:

Google Analytics

The legal basis for using your personal information

We will only collect, use and share your personal information where we are satisfied that we have an appropriate legal basis to do so. This may be because:

- you have provided your consent to us using the personal information
- our use of your personal information is in our legitimate interest as a commercial organisation – in these cases we will look after your information at all times in a way that is proportionate and respects your privacy rights and you have a right to object to processing as explained below
- our use of your personal information is necessary to perform a contract or take steps to enter into a contract with you
- our use of your personal information is necessary to comply with a relevant legal or regulatory obligation that we have

Sharing personal information within Denteler with our service providers, with our regulators

We share your information in the manner and for the purposes described below:

1. within Denteler GmbH, where such disclosure is necessary to provide you with our services or to manage our business
2. with third parties who help manage our business and deliver services. These third parties have agreed to confidentiality restrictions and use any personal information we share with them or which they collect on our behalf solely for the purpose of providing the contracted service to us
3. with credit reference agencies and organisations working to prevent fraud in financial services
4. with our regulators, to comply with all applicable laws, regulations and rules, and requests of law enforcement, regulatory and other governmental agencies we may share in aggregate, statistical form, non-personal information regarding the visitors to our website, traffic patterns, and website usage with our partners, affiliates or advertisers
5. if, in the future, we sell or transfer some or all of our business or assets to a third party, we may disclose information to a potential or actual third party purchaser of our business or assets

The basis on which we do so is set out below.

What processing activities do you undertake that include my personal information?

- We administer and manage your shareholding with the Company and maintain the general records necessary to do so.
- This includes the administrative and management activities that we undertake with respect to governance requirements, for example:
 6. Maintaining statutory registers
 7. Managing compliance with registrations and government agencies
 8. Complying with statutory reporting requirements

What categories of personal information are included in these processing activities?

- We process your identity information and contact information and other information which may be required in certain jurisdictions.

What is the reason for these processing activities?

- We use your personal information to manage our relationship with you.

What are the legal grounds you rely on to carry these out?

- This processing is necessary for the compliance with legal obligations to which the Company is subject. This processing is also necessary for the purpose of the legitimate interests pursued by the Company.

What are the 'legitimate interests' referred to above?

- The Company considers that it has a legitimate interest in operating its business. This includes complying with statutory reporting requirements and compliance obligations for overseas registrations and government agencies.

Who do you share this personal information with?

- Your personal information is shared internally within Denteler at a senior level. In addition, some of your personal information will be shared externally with legal advisers, auditors, Company Secretarial providers, notaries and as otherwise set out in this Notice.
